CS advised the matter will be investigated with other Officials & SAAL film if available. The CS spoke with Alex Day & coach later to be mindful of being 2m clear when overtaking.

Result of CS findings concluded there was insufficient information to support the protest, therefore no further action required.

1600m Women/Over 35 straight final - race stopped after athletes had run approx some 250m -
